 General rule: A2 required

*In general terms, the limited offer of courses taught in English means that exchange students must take part of their courses in Portuguese, and thus, they must have a certain level of Portuguese.

Required Certificate of Portuguese

As a general rule, students do not need to send their Portuguese level certificate to UEM. It is the responsibility of the home university to select their students according to UEM linguistic requirements as mentioned above.
